

Uniforms



Class A uniforms are mandatory. When appropriate and announced, Troop outings and meetings will have a relaxed dress code also referred to as Class B Uniforms (distributed by the Troop).

CLASS A UNIFORM

1. BSA long or short sleeve shirt with the following insignia:
 - o Green Troop numeral "4".
 - o Greater Hudson Valley Council shoulder patch.
 - o Arrow of Light patch - If earned as a Webelos Scout.
 - o Two green epaulets (shoulder loops).
 - o Patrol patch (to be supplied by the Troop).
2. BSA pants (often sold as "convertible" pants, where the legs can be unzipped to make shorts).
3. Neckerchief - supplied by the Troop.
4. Neckerchief slide.
5. BSA Merit Badge Sash (required after the Scout starts earning Merit Badges).
6. BSA belt (optional).
7. BSA socks (optional).
